Criteria	
Residency	 Resident in the USA or territories (American Samoa; Guam; the Northern Mariana Islands; Puerto Rico; United States Virgin Islands)
WPATH Membership	 Member of the World Professional Association for Transgender Health (WPATH) for at least 3 years, in good standing (Membership paid in 2021, 2022, and 2023), prior to the nomination Supports the mission of WPATH/USPATH
Ethics	 Members shall act in accordance with the ethical standards set by professional specialty boards or other professional societies where they hold certification or membership Adhere to the ethical guidelines for members of WPATH Supports the SOC and evidence-based practice
Board experience	 Previous board experience or an understanding of the roles and responsibilities of board members Has competency, skills, and experience needed on the board Applicants for Officer Positions should have demonstrated previous board leadership experience within proven success in board initiatives and projects
Personal Commitment	 Able to attend monthly meetings regularly Can dedicate approximately 20 hours per month to board duties Can commit to a 3-year term Understands the mission and vision of WPATH/USPATH
Conflicts of interest	 No conflicts of interest Committed to a broad agenda to improving transgender health Declares any institution or work-related conflicts, investigations, disciplinary actions.
Diversity	Commitment to diversity and inclusiveness
Consensus	 Maintains a collegial working relationship with other board members Commitment to consensus building
