## Applicants should:

- Have prior experience in organizational leadership
- Have experience with community engagement and participation
- Be committed to consensus building and collaboration
- Be available for a time commitment including monthly phone calls plus an additional 4 hours/month
- Be a member of USPATH
- Share a vision of equity, inclusion, justice, and anti-racism.

People of color, people with disabilities, those of economically disadvantaged backgrounds, and members of under-represented groups in the health and medical fields are strongly encouraged to apply.
