Dear USPATH Members and Attendees,

As we prepare for the **USPATH 2025 Scientific Symposium** at the Hyatt Regency Tamaya Resort & Spa in Santa Ana Pueblo, New Mexico, we want to reaffirm our commitment to ensuring that our meeting is safe, welcoming, and affirming for all attendees—especially those who are transgender, nonbinary, Black, Brown, Indigenous, and multiply marginalized.

### Safety of the Venue and Location

Our conference site was chosen for its unique setting, privacy, and commitment to guest safety. We have taken the following steps to safeguard our community:

- **Security Assessment:** Conducted with a third-party consultant to evaluate local climate, accessibility, and potential risks.
- **On-Site Security:** A professional security team trained in cultural competency and trauma-informed response will be present throughout the event.
- **Hotel Coordination:** Staff have been briefed on our community's needs and are committed to creating an affirming environment.
- **Incident Reporting Protocols:** Attendees will receive clear instructions for confidential reporting of any safety concerns.
