


This panel uplifts the lived realities and cultural wisdom of transgender and gender-diverse communities across generations, geographies, and systems of oppression. Through presentations rooted in identity, behavioral health, community organizing, and public health, speakers will challenge the silos of knowledge and amplify intersectional strategies for health equity. Attendees will gain practical insights into trauma-informed care, culturally grounded interventions, and decolonial approaches to identity, advocacy, and belonging. Together, we ask: What does liberation look like in gender-affirming care and who must be included for it to be real?

From a variety of perspectives, we will discuss intergenerational healthcare, public health, and behavioral interventions that affirm rather than erase - our speakers embody intersectionality in action. The panel brings together academic expertise, lived experience, community advocacy, and regional representation in a way that affirms the diverse realities of our field.
